

Policy Number 3: Circulation of information for Member Organisations.

1. The Council would normally circulate information on behalf of member organisations provided:
 - a) The event is organised with a view to attracting national attendance.
 - b) The issue is of national significance and of interest to the panth.
 - c) The event or issue is not divisive in the Panth
 - d) The material is clearly laid out as who is leading on the event, issue etc.
2. The information is electronically distributable
3. There is no additional cost to the Council
4. The materials do not promote those activities that the Council has decided it will remain silent on.
5. The request for distribution will normally be restricted to no more than three times a year. However, when organisations are involved in campaigns of a Panthic nature which the Council has agreed to support then there will no such restriction
