



# Religion

As at 30 June 2013 just over 4,600 prisoners (58% of the prison population) in Scotland indicated that they held religious beliefs. Of these, 93% were Christian (of various denominations). Muslim prisoners accounted for 4.4%. Together Buddhist, Sikh, Jewish, Hindu and other religions accounted for 2.7% of the religious prison population. Just over 3,270 prisoners (42% of the prison population) held no religious beliefs.

# **Definition of Ethnic Group:**

#### The essential conditions are:

- 1) a long-shared history, of which the group is conscious as distinguishing it from other groups, and the memory of which it keeps alive;
- 2) a cultural tradition of its own, including family and social customs and manners, often but not necessarily associated with religious observance.

# In addition to the above two essential characteristics the following characteristics are, relevant:

- 3) either a common geographical origin, or descent from a small number of common ancestors;
- 4) a common language, not necessarily peculiar to the group;
- 5) a common literature peculiar to the group;
- 6) a common religion different from that of neighbouring groups or from the general community surrounding it;
- 7) being a minority or being an oppressed or a dominant group within a larger community, for example a conquered people (say, the inhabitants of England shortly after the Norman conquest) and their conquerors might both be ethnic groups.

A test set out by Richardson,  $\underline{J}$  in the County Court is similar and summed up as:

"... presumed common past, even if not drawn from what in biological terms is a common racial stock. It is that combination which gives them an historically determined social identity in their own eyes and in the eyes of those outside the group. They have a distinct social identity based not simply on group cohesion and solidarity but also on their belief as to their historical antecedents."
